ALL BREEDING ESTABLISHMENTS

RWITC LTD. 2018 ANNUAL SALE

1. Salient points of the Sale are as under :-
 - (a) The Sale will be held in Mumbai on **12 Feb** and **13 Feb 2018**.
 - (b) All horses **MUST** pass through the ring.
 - (c) Entries close on **31 Oct 2017**.
 - (d) Entry fee is **Rs. 7,500/- + G.S.T. as applicable** per lot and payable at the time of entry.
 - (e) Organised Rolls will start on **08 Feb 2018**.
 - (f) At the time of entry, all horses will be certified for soundness by a Veterinarian on the Panel nominated by the Stewards of RWITC Ltd.
 - (g) Upon arrival in Mumbai, these horses will be re-checked for soundness by the Sr. Veterinary Officer of RWITC Ltd.
 - (h) In order to help long distance breeding establishments entering horses for the Sale, a facility will be provided by RWITC Ltd for their horses to arrive in Mumbai Race course directly and in case Vendors desire to break journey of their animals, they may do so by bringing their horses to Pune Race on or before 30 Jan 2018 and then take them to Mumbai Race Course for the Sale. However, all such horses must arrive in the Annual Sale Stables, Mumbai latest by 5.00 p.m. on 07 Feb 2018.

2. Further details, Conditions of Sales and Letter Inviting Entries for the Sale will be forwarded to all concerned by 25 Aug 2017.

Covering Certificates - 2017

3. Reference Para 53(a)(i) of the Rules and Requirements for Registration of Thoroughbred and Half-bred Horses in India - effective from 1 Dec 2014. Covering Certificates for the period 01 February to 31 July 2017 may be processed without any fee, provided they are submitted on-line by **31 Aug 2017**.

List Of Stock Sheltered

4. Reference Para 87 of Rules and Requirements for Registration of Thoroughbred and Half-bred Horses in India - effective from 1 Dec 2014.

5. A list of stock sheltered at each Breeding Establishment as on **01 Sep 2017** is due to be received by **30 Sep 2017**. All Breeding Establishments are requested to take note of the same.

6. Details of stock as per records of the Stud Book Authority of India may be viewed by Breeding Establishments using the online portal. Amendments required to the list may be informed to us via email.

Passports – Foals of 2016

7. Passports of 503 foals of 2016 have already been despatched to various Breeding Establishments. All concerned are requested to kindly identify the yearlings with the corresponding passports and revert to us in case any discrepancies are noticed. In many cases, we are yet to receive acknowledgments for receipt of these passports.

8. Passports of 129 foals of 2016 have been prepared. However, in view of their Stud Accounts being in debit, their dispatches are pending.

SCHEDULE OF EQUINE INFLUENZA VACCINATION OF FOALS BORN IN 2016

Equine Influenza (EI) vaccination of foals born in 2016 by the breeders/stud farms is absolutely mandatory before they arrive for Annual Sale in Mumbai or directly into race courses. The following time-bound schedule of three doses of CALVENZA vaccination should be carried out as detailed below:-

1. First EI vaccination : 1st week of October 2017
2. Second EI vaccination : 1st week of November 2017
3. Third EI vaccination : 1st week of December 2017

Notes:

1. Last EI vaccination should be preferably completed at least TWO weeks before the foals move out of their breeding establishments
2. Date of each vaccination, batch number of the vaccine and vaccine sticker should be pasted on the Passport of respective foals. Vaccination is strictly time-bound and every effort should be made to adhere to the above guidelines.
3. No foal shall be allowed to enter Annual sale or any race course premises without a complete course of vaccination and proper vaccination records.

CHARGES FOR COLLECTION AND EIA – GLANDERS TESTING OF 2 YR-OLDS

1. All foals of 2016 that desire to enter a racing center at any time must initially have their blood sample drawn by the Veterinary Officer of a Turf Authority and tested by the Diagnostic Research Laboratory, situated in RWITC Ltd, Pune. Samples drawn by other person/s and tests conducted at other laboratories thereon shall not be accepted by Turf Authorities of India.
2. To undertake mandatory testing of Two-year olds, the Veterinary Officers will be visiting breeding establishments from 05th Jan 2018 to 15th Jan 2018. The programme of visit of Veterinary Officers is dependent on flight schedules and availability of reservation and is likely to change at short notice. The Veterinary Officers will forward their itinerary directly to the breeding establishment(s) concerned.
3. If a breeding establishment / person fails to have all its foals of 2016 sampled in this period for any reason whatsoever including the reason that the foal will go to a racing center more than 4 months later, etc, such breeding establishment/person shall at that time be required to request a Turf Authority to specifically send a Veterinary Officer for drawing the sample. The breeding establishment / person concerned would then have to mandatorily meet an additional expenditure of Rs. 30,000/- representing the additional cost for drawing samples at a later date at any given breeding establishment.
4. A supplementary reference set of Laboratory reports of all 2016 born foals, whose blood samples were collected by the Official Veterinarians and tested by Diagnostic Research Laboratories (DRL) Pune, will be made available by 1st March 2018 to all the Sr. Veterinary Officers of race clubs for their verification/confirmation of this mandatory compliance whenever a horse is seeking entry to race course anytime later during 2018.
5. NO 2016 born foal shall be allowed into a race course if it was not initially sampled by the Official Vets and tested only at the DRL, Pune. For further clarification on this issue, The Technical Director DRL, Pune or The Chairman, Veterinary Commission, Madras Race Club, Chennai may be approached.
6. Breeding establishments are requested to extend their full co-operation to the representative of the Turf Authority by keeping the yearlings ready for sample collection and also ensure that their Passports are available for identification. In case Passports are not available, the Certificate of Identity should be presented.
7. A representative of the breeding establishment must be present at the time of collection of the samples. Movements of yearlings should be avoided till the samples are collected.
8. No foal of 2016 will be accepted at any Racing Centre either for Auction Sales or for Racing unless their samples are drawn by a Veterinary Officer of a Turf Authority and they are negative for EIA and Glanders. The results of the test will be intimated to the breeding establishment directly by the Sr. Veterinary Officer concerned.
9. **All breeding establishments are requested to hand over a Demand Draft of Rs. 1,000/- per sample being sample collection charges to the concerned Veterinary Officer, who collects the samples.**
10. The Veterinary Officers need to hand over all the samples to Diagnostic Research Laboratory, RWITC, Pune by 15th Jan 2018 for EIA and Glanders testing.
11. The Diagnostic Research Laboratory, RWITC, Pune conducts the tests and forwards the results of EIA and Glanders to the Senior / Chief Veterinary Officers of the Turf Authorities by 20th Jan 2018.
12. The last date for receipt of repeat samples is 20th Jan 2018 and the results of the repeat samples or other samples situations, shall be released before 30th Jan 2018.
13. The Laboratory testing charges for EIA and Glanders is Rs. 600/- per sample. The Diagnostic Research Laboratory, RWITC, Pune will be conducting the tests at their Lab in Pune.

14. The Stud Farms are requested to note that all matters pertaining to service charges and the results of the test are addressed ONLY to the concerned Turf Authority,
