#### ALL BREEDING ESTABLISHMENTS

##### Horses Traveling To and From Breeding Establishments

1. Attention of all concerned is drawn to Para 97 and 98 of the Rules and Requirements for Registration of Thoroughbred and Half-bred Horses in India - effective from 01 Dec 2014 that all horses must travel to and from the breeding establishments with their identity documents / passports. A breeding establishment accepting horses without their identification papers does so at its own risk and leaves itself open to a fine of Rs. 10,000/- per instance for negligence unless the inability to obtain the said papers is reported to the S.B.A.I. immediately. **Identification papers of all horses sheltered at a stud are liable to be inspected without prior notice.**

2. **Movement of weanlings / yearlings.** A passport will be issued to a yearling after it has been parentage validated. When weanlings and yearlings move from one breeding establishment to another, the dispatching establishment must send xerox copies of their Notification of Birth or Certificate of Identity to the receiving establishment. The S.B.A.I. will not be liable for correct identification of youngstock, which moves from one stud to another and it should not be approached in this connection.

3. Non-compliance of the Rules by sending and recipient Breeding Establishments would attract strict disciplinary action by the Stud Book Authority of India.

## Notifications of Birth

5. Para 63 of the Rules and Requirements for Registration of Thoroughbred and Half-bred Horses in India is reproduced for the benefit of all concerned: -

(a) **Foalings up to 26 December of the year of Covering shall be notified to S.B.A.I. within 48 hours** of the birth of the foal.

(b) **Foalings between 27 December and 28 December of the year of Covering shall be notified to S.B.A.I. within 24 hours** of the birth of the foal.

(c) **Foalings subsequent to 28 December of the year of Covering shall be notified to S.B.A.I. within 6 hours** of the birth of the foal.

(d) Information stating the date of birth, colour and sex of any foal born on or before 31st December of each year in which the mares have been covered shall be given to the S.B.A.I. by fax / email and in exceptional circumstances, on telephone to any of the designated officials of the S.B.A.I. in the aforesaid prescribed time limit. All information required as above shall be confirmed to the S.B.A.I. in writing, in the prescribed form of S.B.A.I., duly signed within 30 days from the date of the above notification to S.B.A.I.

(e) **Foals born between 01 January in the year after covering and on / or before 31st December of that year** shall be notified to S.B.A.I. within 90 days of the birth of such foals, stating the date of birth, colour, sex of the foal in the prescribed form to S.B.A.I. (copies of which may be obtained from the official website of the S.B.A.I.) and must state the name of the owner / breeder, the foal's colour, sex, pedigree, date and place of birth all distinguishing marks and proposed brands in the diagram provided on the form.

(f) Persons authorised in writing by the S.B.A.I. or the Keeper of the Indian Stud Book or the Registrar of the Indian Stud Book as representing them are hereby entitled to carry out surprise checks at breeding establishments for verification of the date of birth of foals born each year. In case it is noticed or found that a foal born on or before 31st December of any year has not been reported to the S.B.A.I., within the prescribed time as mentioned in Rule 63 (a), (b) or (c) above, the S.B.A.I. shall take a serious view in the matter and shall be entitled after due enquiry and personal hearing, if any, requested for by the owner of the breeding establishment to impose a minimum fine of Rs. 75,000/- and not exceeding Rs. 2,50,000/-. In addition to the fine imposable by the S.B.A.I. as aforesaid, the S.B.A.I. shall also be entitled, at its sole discretion, to decide not to register the foal.

## Passports - Foals of 2016

6. Passports of foals of 2016 have been dispatched to Breeding Establishments.

7. It may kindly be noted that the Veterinarians from the Turf Authorities of India are scheduled to visit your Breeding Establishment for collection of blood samples for Coggins, etc. Passports would be required by them to facilitate easy identification.

8. Breeding Establishments were requested to acknowledge receipt of passports. However, some acknowledgements are still awaited. If any Breeding Establishments have not received passports, they should inform the Stud Book Department immediately, i.e. by **20 Dec 2017**. Thereafter, it will be presumed that the passports have been received.

9. Breeding Establishments are requested to identify the yearlings physically with the markings in the passport. In case any major discrepancies are noticed, the passports may be returned for amendments.

### **Registration of Breeding Stock**

10. The following requirements for registration of breeding stock, classified separately for Indian-bred horses and foreign-bred horses are as given below :-

#### **Indian-bred Horses**

(a) All requirements specified in Para 37, 38 and 39 of the Rules and Requirements for Registration of Thoroughbred and Half-bred Horses in India - Effective from 01 Dec 2014, may kindly be noted.

(b) **Hair samples will be required if the horses are born before 2007**. In this context, it may be noted that foals born in India with effect from the foal-crop of 2007 have been parentage validated by DNA analysis. Since the DNA profile of the horses born from 2007 onwards is available with us, hair samples are not required again for registration for breeding. However, in few cases, if there is a requirement, the Breeding Establishments will be specifically requested to submit hair samples.

#### **Foreign-bred Horses (Imported Mare/Stallion)**

(c) All requirements specified in Para 40, 41 and 42 of the Rules and Requirements for Registration of Thoroughbred and Half-bred Horses in India - Effective from 01 Dec 2014, may kindly be noted.

(d) Hair samples will be required in all cases.

11. Envelopes for collection of hair samples for breeding stock will be sent upon a specific request from the concerned Breeding Establishment.

### **Ownership**

12. **Foals of 2016** will NOT be under the jurisdiction of the Stud Book Authority of India w.e.f. 01 January 2018 if they are already stationed at one of the recognised racing centers. Sale / Transfer deeds of these horses should be forwarded to the respective Turf Authorities of India, subsequent to that date.
