ALL BREEDING ESTABLISHMENTS

RWITC Ltd Annual Sale 2018

1. **Entries.** A total of **261** entries have been accepted for the Sale and some provisionally, pending completion of documentation formalities.
2. The draw for the same has been completed.

Sale / Transfers of Young Horses

3. Breeding Establishments are requested to note that the Stud Book Authority of India will register Sales / Transfers of foals, weanlings, yearlings and 2YO's (*which are still at breeding establishments and not registered with any recognized Turf Authority or Race Club provided the passport is lodged for endorsement*).
4. Breeding Establishments are requested to kindly note this and forward Sale/Transfer forms of horses appropriately.

Fees for Registration of Breeding Stock

5. The registration fees for Breeding stock including GST @ 18% is as given below :-

	Regn. fee	GST	Total
(a) Registration of a Breeding Establishment	- Rs. 1,00,000/- + 18,000/-	=	Rs. 1,18,000/-
(b) Foreign-bred stallion	- Rs. 2,00,000/- + 36,000/-	=	Rs. 2,36,000/-
(c) Foreign-bred broodmare	- Rs. 45,000/- + 8,100/-	=	Rs. 53,100/-
(d) Indian-bred stallion	- Rs. 37,500/- + 6,750/-	=	Rs. 44,250/-
(e) Indian-bred broodmare	- Rs. 7,500/- + 1,350/-	=	Rs. 8,850/-

Casualties and Movements

7. As per Para 89 and 90 of the Rules and Requirements for Registration of Thoroughbred and Half-bred Horses in India, casualties and movements of stallions, broodmares, yearlings, foals (even those whose Notification of Birth have not been submitted) must be reported within 90 days.

8. It may kindly be noted that in the event of casualties and movements not being reported within the stipulated time frame, a penalty of **Rs. 3,000/- + Rs. 540/-** (GST @ 18%) for each occurrence is liable to be imposed.

Equine Influenza (EI) Vaccination Protocol for Two-Year-Olds

9. It may kindly be noted that as per the Protocol for Equine Influenza (EI) Vaccination, passports have to be produced to the visiting Veterinarians for necessary endorsements, etc.

10. Since in some cases the passports may not be available for endorsements, the Veterinary Commission suggests that the Veterinarian administering the vaccine may sign on a Verification Sheet mentioning the details of the horse viz. its pedigree, date of vaccination, batch number, etc. For brevity, a format is appended as under:-

11. Subsequently, when the passports are received, the concerned Breeding Establishments may have these details endorsed on the passports by one of the Senior Veterinary Officers of the five Turf Authorities of India. In case of horses being entered for the Annual Sale 2018, they could be endorsed by the Veterinary Officer on duty at the Mumbai Race Course.
